

New Hangar Development planned @ New Garden Flying Field

PennDOT announced on October 29th New Garden Flying Field was successful in competing for a grant through the Multi Modal Transportation Fund for site preparation including drainage, taxiway/apron paving, storm water management, and the construction of seven t-hangars and two box hangars. Out of a total fund of \$60 million PennDOT received over 260 qualified applications requesting upwards of \$350 million. It took several months for them to determine who would receive a portion of the \$60 million and we are happy to announce New Garden Flying Field will be receiving \$979,431.


This improvement and valuable asset will provide a positive revenue stream, promoting a sustainable airport in New Garden Township for many years to come. At this early stage we have not heard when funding will be released but we are preparing so the airport is ready once we get the go ahead from PennDOT.



Runway Reconstruction Project

New Garden Flying Field is getting ready for the Runway Reconstruction Project to start June or July next year. This total reconstruction project will include site preparation, runway widening, paving, new lights and a new electrical feed into the airport. The airport is receiving an Airport Improvement Grant from the State which will pay for 95% of the project. The additional 5% local match will be paid out of the Airport Fund. Due to the extensive scope of this project the projected completion date will not be until 2016, however the runway will only be closed for 15-30 days.
