5K Race, family fun walk & Kiddie run. RUN THE RUNWAY Sunday morning of the Festival of Flight.



Ford Tri-Motor Rides Coming to N57. June 9th-12th.

Experience the golden age of aviation and take flight in a Ford Tri-Motor, giving passengers an opportunity to travel back to the early days of luxurious commercial flight.

From 1926 through 1933, Ford Motor Company built 199 Tri-Motors. EAA's model 4-AT-E was the 146th of Ford's innovative assembly line and first flew on August 21, 1929. It was sold to Pitcairn Aviation's passenger division, Eastern Air Transport.

Our local EAA Chapter 240 is hosting a stop along the US tour right here at New Garden Flying Field.

Don't miss this once in a life time opportunity to go for a ride in this historical aircraft. The Ford Tri-Motor will be at the airport June 9th-12th.

Runway Reconstruction Project

Over the last few years the airport has been preparing for a major runway reconstruction project. The largest asset for any airport is the runway. Due to the age and many years of use, the runways's pavement is considered to be in poor condition based on FAA (Federal Aviation Administration) and Pennsylvania BOA (Bureau of Aviation) standards. Other non standard considerations include the primary runway lighting as well as non standard safety area surrounding the runway surface, including many tree obstructions inside the approach surfaces of the airport. A Federal and State Aviation Grant has been secured by the airport to fund 95% of the cost for this extensive project. The remainder 5% will be paid through the airport's operational budget. We look for this project to begin early April and will continue through the remainder of 2016 and into 2017. The runway is expected to only be closed during the milling and replacement of the pavement which is expected to last only 15 days.
