School is back in session and Fall is upon us, which means cooler weather is also here to stay. Thanks once again for your interest in the happenings of New Garden Township. Following is an update on a number of matters of general interest:

**Lamborn House** – The Lamborn House in New Garden Park has new tenants. The Historical Commission of New Garden has renovated the house over the past few years and in June the house was rented to a local couple. The Historical Commission and the Township are thrilled to see the house used again and to provide a great home for the tenants in the Park.

**Sale of the Township Sewer System** – The sale of the Township's sewer system is still making progress. Evaluations of the system by professional consultants are almost complete. The hope is to have a decision and agreement in place before the end of 2015.

**Road Master Position** – At their meeting on August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2015, the Board of Supervisors appointed Jeff Stewart as Township Road Master. The Road Master serves New Garden Township as the Assistant to the Public Works Director. Jeff has served New Garden for 11 years in the Public Works department. Congratulations Jeff.

**2016 Township Budget** – It is that time of year when every Township/Borough begins work of the next year's budget. Budget meetings for New Garden are scheduled for Mondays October 5<sup>th</sup>, November 2<sup>nd</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> and Monday December 7<sup>th</sup>. All meetings starting at 7PM.

**Comprehensive Plan Update** – The committee that was tasked to review the 2005 Comprehensive Plan update has completed its work. The Township has applied to the Chester County Planning Commission for a grant to help with the full plan update. This process will hopefully begin in January of 2016. Once the process begins volunteers will be needed to serve on the Comprehensive Plan Update Committee.
